- Duties:** **THEA 010** - Introduction to Acting  
(4) Unit course (3 hours lecture and 1 hour discussion)  
This course is an introduction to acting in theatre, film, television, and performance art. Through exercises, lectures, videos, and on-site visits, explores the work of actors and their collaborations with other artists in historical and contemporary settings.
- THEA 109** - Acting: The Process  
(4) Unit course (3 hours lecture and 2 hours studio)  
This course is a comprehensive introduction to the process of acting. Topics include theories, history, and expressive skills related to theatrical performance.
- Salary:** \$4,766.96 per course.
- Qualifications:** MA, MFA, PhD or equivalent experience (3 years professional and/or university directing experience.) A record of professional and/or university directing is required. Teaching experience at the university level is desired.
